



# Undercover<sup>®</sup> Rules-of-the-Road



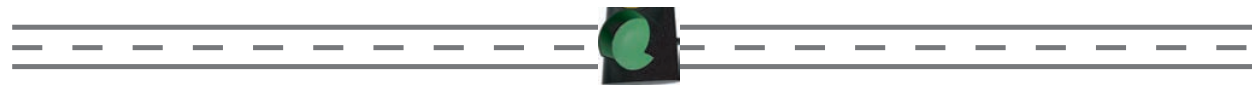
## IMPORTANT INFORMATION



- NEVER setup your Undercover<sup>®</sup> without properly anchoring.
- NEVER leave your shelter unattended.
- NEVER burn open flames beneath your shelter.
- NEVER forcefully setup or takedown.
- NEVER assume there is no-wind.
- NEVER assume that light-rain will not pocket water.
- NEVER setup near overhanging or other electrical wires.
- NEVER setup in an electrical storm.



- CAUTION any unattended shelter can cause serious injury and or damage.
- CAUTION always properly anchor your Undercover<sup>®</sup>.
- CAUTION electrical wires can cause serious injury when in contact with frame.
- CAUTION be careful not to pinch-fingers between scissor bars while operating.
- CAUTION light-rain or snow will eventually pocket and destroy the frame.
- CAUTION forceful operation can damage or destroy frame.
- CAUTION be sure the polyester-skin is completely dry before storing.



- ALWAYS properly anchor.
- ALWAYS takedown in wind greater than 10 mph.
- ALWAYS takedown in an electrical storm.
- ALWAYS be alert to pocketing water in light-rain.
- ALWAYS refer to operating instructions, if in doubt.
- ALWAYS contact Undercover<sup>®</sup> for service questions or replacement parts.
